DateTimeConditionExpression is used to evaluate a DateTime property (of field or variable). Depending on the outcome, the result will then be either DateTime1 or DateTime2.

Explanation of the example

Line 9 evaluates if DateTimeExample1 is equal to DateTimeExample2. If so, DateTimeExample1 will be assigned to the CalculatedDateTimeProperty DateTimeResult, otherwise DateTimeExample2 will be assigned to DateTimeResult.
