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What it is

StringNvlExpression is used specify how to treat a NULL value in a String property (or field or variable). If the String appears to be NULL, it will be assigned a default value or a specified value.

Code example

public ReadOnlyStringProperty StringNvlExample{ get { return  
CalculatedStringProperty(() =>      Operation.EditItem.Name.Nvl()  
;  }}
```

Explanation of the example

The example above works as follows.

- Line 1 defines a `ReadOnlyStringProperty` with the name `StringNvlExample`.
- In Line 5 and 6 the content of this property is going to be calculated and assigned.
- In line 6, the `String Operation.EditItem.Number` is evaluated, by adding `.Nvl`.
- If the `String` appears to be `NULL`, then `StringNvlExample` will be assigned the value after `Nvl` between parentheses. When nothing is specified, the default value will be an empty string `""`.
